Please note the following:

- Pre-registration is mandatory.
- Early Bird registration fee is \$20 for Categories 2 & 3. Payment can be made by cash, cheque, or etransfer. Receipts available upon request. Cheques payable to <u>Downtown Williams Lake</u>.
- Registration fee after November 2 is \$30 for Categories 2 & 3.
- You MUST have a copy of your vehicle insurance on hand Saturday morning for the Parade Marshall. *Proof of insurance for all vehicles is required for participation*
- It is illegal to throw anything from a parade float. Candy or items may be handed out by persons accompanying a float. Nothing should be thrown.
- All children must have adult supervision.
- Because this is a family friendly event, any organization promoting the use of alcohol, tobacco, cannabis, or adult themes will not be permitted.
- Please stay on the float during the parade.
- Please keep up! Stay within 3 car lengths of the float in front of you!
- Due to unpredictable weather, we ask that no animals be included in the parade.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Overall Winner Commercial (first and second), Overall Winner Community/Non-Profit (first and second), and honourable mentions.
